## Route overview

3 Day walks:

- Saturday 9 June: Aroona –Pigeon Bore (along Heysen Trail) – Part way down Bathtub Creek, then return to Aroona by same route. 14km
- Sunday 10 June: Yuluna Loop to East of Aroona, and side trip to hill “550” on Heysen Trail – great views. 12km
- Monday 11 June : Walk from Aroona to Brachina Gorge Road to be picked up by bus at noon.
