Heysen Trail Kapunda to Marrabel

Travel: recommendations, times, car shuffling, parking etc.

All meet at Kapunda Bakery & Café (adjacent BankSA building, Main Street Kapunda). Depart from here at 11am. Drive to Hamilton, all passengers and gear get out here. Drivers go on to Marrabel to leave most of the cars, return to Hamilton in one or two vehicles where the walk will start. This will be close to mid-day by this time.

On Sunday, a 9am start will get you back to Marrabel by midday.

A large rainwater tank is located at the campsite.

Head south from Hamilton, past the old church on the left. Then take the first road on the right and head down to the end where the Heysen trail intersects. From here, you just follow the Heysen trail to the hut, then on to Marrabel the next day.

The map below shows the location. Marshall's hut is located just north of Peter's Hill.


